FAQs

I am a GT student and want my spouse to receive treatment at GT Stamps Health Services. Is this possible?

Yes, your spouse may be treated at GT Stamps Health Services.

1. The GT student must be eligible and have paid the health fee for the semester
2. Spouse pays a semester health fee

What is the Health Fee?

The Health Fee is for services at GT Stamps Health Services only and is not insurance. A Health Fee is required for all GT students and spouses of GT students for use of GT Stamps Health Services each semester.

How do I use my GT student health insurance policy?

GT Stamps Health Services will be the primary care facility and to see an outside physician, a referral must be obtained from a GT MD or the student insurance will not cover the services.

Will the GT Stamps Health Services Pharmacy file claims to my insurance?

Students and spouses must pay the full amount at time of service and the GT Stamps Health services Insurance Office can assist with filing for reimbursement from your insurance company upon request.

If my spouse and I are both GT students should we purchase one insurance plan or purchase separate insurance plans?

It is suggested that you purchase two separate plans. This way you both can get the discounted student rates with the GT Student health insurance.

If I have annual GT student health insurance coverage but I graduate, do I still have coverage?

You will have the coverage per the coverage termination date but you will not be able to use GT Stamps Health Services anymore so you will need to choose a doctor on the PPO Network listed on the student insurance website.

Why is the cost for my spouse/child more than the student rate for the GT student health insurance?

The student insurance is set up to give the student discounted rate and because not everyone is the 'typical' student, the spouse/child coverage was made available for those in need of this type of coverage.

Why do I have to enroll/renew my student health insurance each fall semester?

The student insurance is set up on a fall to fall policy year and must be renewed each fall semester for continuation of coverage (if student is eligible).
